COVID-19 FACTS:

- This coronavirus can be transmitted from person to person.
- Symptoms may appear as few as two days or as many as 14 days after exposure.
- This coronavirus can affect people of any age; older people and those with pre-existing medical conditions, like asthma or heart disease may be more vulnerable to developing severe symptoms.
- Healthcare workers and others who have close contact with COVID-19 patients will have a higher risk of infection.
- Antibiotics cannot prevent or treat COVID-19.
- There are currently no medications available to prevent or treat this coronavirus.
- Disinfectants kill a wider range of microorganisms than sanitizers.
- The illness causes a range of symptoms, including fever, cough, shortness of breath, breathing difficulties, pneumonia, kidney failure and death.
- It appears people showing no symptoms may be able to spread the virus.

COVID-19 CLEANING PROTOCOLS

- Initial walk-through and assessment of work area
- Site preparation, containment and security
- Don all Personal Protection Equipment (PPE)
- Placement of DOP Certified, HEPA Air Moving Machine (scrubber mode)
- Begin wipe-down protocol
 - Start at furthest point or room from site entrance
 - Wipe all vertical, horizontal, and touch-point services
 - Remove all detachable items, sanitize, return item
 - Dry wipe floor on egress
- Allow the disinfectant agent to set undisturbed/activate for a minimum of 10 Min.
- Begin HEPA vacuuming of all horizontal, vertical and touch-point surfaces
- Administer Anodizing Micro Dry Fogger throughout entire site
